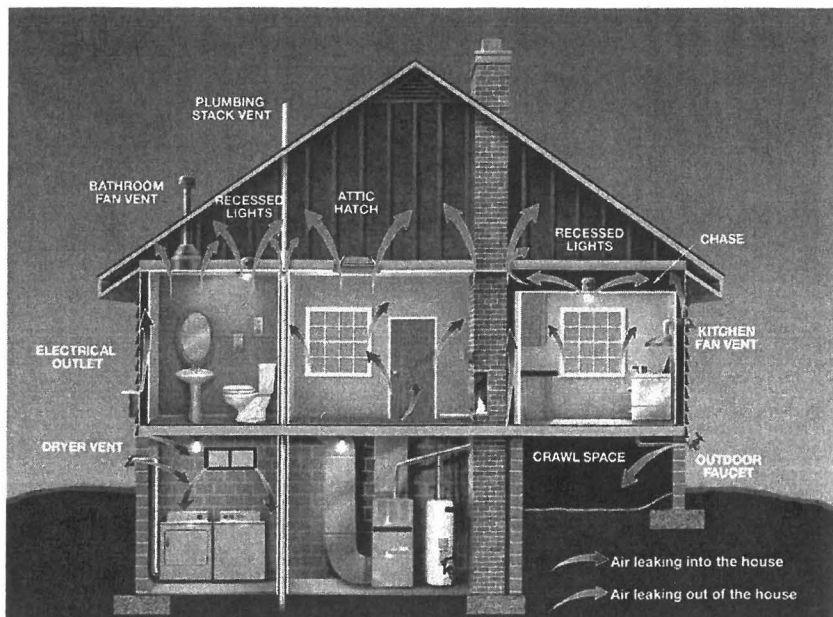

Weatherization reduces household fuel costs between 20% and 25%

The Weatherization Program sponsored by SCMCAA is a free service for homeowners or renters who qualify. Weatherization crews insulate and repair homes to make them more energy efficient.

Weatherizing can make a home warmer during the winter and help save heating dollars.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All applicants must meet income guidelines. Renters must have owner approval and owner participation to receive services.
