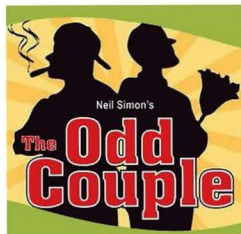

A Laura Ingalls Wilder Christmas

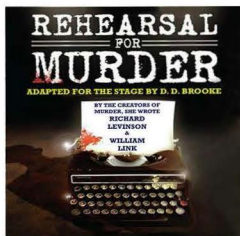
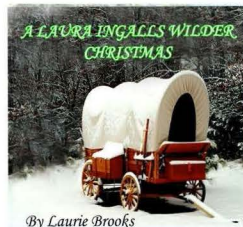

By Oscar Hammerstein II and Joshua Logan

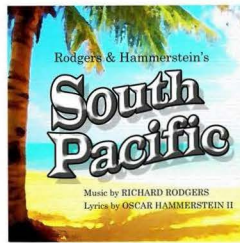
